Norton Place Health and Social Care Centre

Norton Place, operated by the Southend East Primary Care Network, is a collaboration of six GP practices that provides care to approximately 37,200 patients from Southchurch, Thorpe Bay, and Shoeburyness.

Patients using the essential services provided at Norton Place are struggling with nearby parking, forcing them to cut their health appointments short.

Norton Place has a small on-site car park. However, due to the high demand for the services provided, this can often fill up quickly. This results in many patients being forced to find alternative parking.

Opposite Norton Place, there are parking bays situated in Ness Road. Currently, these bays restrict patients to parking for only 1 hour with no return in 4 hours. Many appointments at Norton Place can take up to 3 hours, and this puts patients in a difficult predicament and forces patients to use nearby residential roads.

This Council therefore resolves:

1. That parking restrictions on the bays in Ness Road are increased to 3 hours with no return in 4 hours to enable patients to use the parking bays.
