## Announced Inspection of Safeguarding and Looked After Children Services **Action Plan**

#### **Purpose of Report** 1.

- 1.1 To present the action plan arising from the announced inspection of Safeguarding and Looked After Children Services in June 2012 for Cabinet approval.

- 3.1 The report to Cabinet on the 4th of September 2012 'Announced Inspection of Safeguarding and Looked After Children Services' detailed the background and the findings of the joint Ofsted and CQC Inspection in June 2012. Both service areas were judged good overall with five areas judged as outstanding.
- 3.2 There were 7 recommendations made where inspectors felt development could be implemented to improve our safeguarding of children in respect of services for looked after children. The report specified timescales for completion.
- 3.3 Since the inspection report was received officers have been developing this action plan to ensure that the areas for development identified are adequately addressed.
- The action plan attached as Appendix 1 reports progress to 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2012 3.4 owing to the report deadlines for publication of Cabinet Reports.
