# New Scrutiny Committees - review

## A Part 1 Agenda Item

#### 1. Purpose of Report

Review of the new Scrutiny Committees.

2.1 That the report be noted.

#### 3. Background

3.1 In January 2013, the Council endorsed revisions to the Scrutiny Committees, to take effect in the 2013 / 14 Municipal Year. Following discussion at the Chairmen's Scrutiny Forum in February 2013 and subsequent agreement by the 3 Scrutiny Committees at their meetings held on 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> April 2013, it was agreed that the Economic & Environmental, Children and Lifelong Learning and Community Services and Culture Scrutiny Committees would be re designated as – Place, People and Policy & Resources Scrutiny Committees.

The terms of reference for the 3 Scrutiny Committees are attached at <u>Appendix</u> <u>1</u>.

- 3.2 It was also agreed that the changes to the Scrutiny Committees should be reviewed after 9 months to enable any amendments to be made for the 2014 / 2015 Municipal Year.
- 3.3 This report looks at the operation of the new Scrutiny Committees so far.

## 4. New Scrutiny Committees

4.1 We have undertaken an analysis of the work of the new Scrutiny Committees so far during this Municipal Year. There have been 3 ordinary / scheduled meetings so far, on the following dates:

Place - 8<sup>th</sup> July, 7<sup>th</sup> October and 25<sup>th</sup> November 2013; People - 9<sup>th</sup> July, 8<sup>th</sup> October and 26<sup>th</sup> November 2013; and Policy & Resources - 11<sup>th</sup> July, 10<sup>th</sup> October and 28<sup>th</sup> November 2013.

- 4.2 Additional Scrutiny Committee meetings have also taken place, as follows -People Scrutiny Cttee on 2<sup>nd</sup> September and 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2013; and Place Scrutiny Cttee on 16<sup>th</sup> October 2013.
- 4.3 An analysis of the meetings has been carried out and this information is attached at <u>Appendix 2</u>. From the data, the average length of time for each ordinary Scrutiny Committee meeting is -
  - Place 3 hours 30 mins
  - People 3 hours 10 mins
  - Policy & Resources 2hrs 20 mins

The additional Place meeting lasted 2hrs 40 mins and the 2 additional People Scrutiny Committees each lasted 3hrs 15 mins.

- 4.4 At the meeting in February 2013, the Forum expressed concern around the workload of the People Scrutiny Cttee and also cross cutting issues such as crime & disorder matters. These issues have both been helped by Cllr Woodley's excellent idea to have separate member briefings / presentations and this issue is explored elsewhere on the agenda for today's meeting. On occasions of course, there will still be a need to have briefings at a Scrutiny Committee meeting.
- 4.5 The names of the 3 Scrutiny Committees does not seem to be an issue, the workloads of the Committees are fairly even and the distribution seems to be working well.
