Ref: Westborough Area 20 mph Zone Phase 3 Traffic Calming proposals

You may recall that the Borough Council consulted local residents and businesses on proposals to introduce an area wide 20 mph zone, incorporating speed cushions in your area in September this year. The principle of the scheme was generally well supported. The proposed scheme has now been modified to take account of the main issues raised during the consultation exercise and includes the following main features:

- 20 mph Zones with zone entry/exit signs and new carriageway markings
- Speed cushions to reduce traffic speed
- Conversion of existing two-way roads within area to One-Way Streets

The Council is currently undertaking statutory consultation on the traffic orders necessary to implement the scheme. Copies of the statutory notices relating to the proposals are attached. The Council would welcome your support for the scheme which it believes will improve the safety and environment of Westborough Area. However, should you wish to object to any of the proposals you have the right to do so in accordance with the procedures set out in the attached notices.

The Southend-on-Sea Borough Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 38 and 84 (and part IV of Schedule 9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will amend the above-mentioned Consolidation Order by adding the items listed in the Schedule below thereby, introducing one-way street traffic flows and restricting the speed of traffic to 20 mph in the road described.
