1. Purpose of Report

To inform Members of the work programme currently being undertaken by the Traffic Management and Road Safety Team.

3. Background

- 3.1 The general works programme for the Traffic Management and Road Safety Team (formerly Demand Management) are agreed each year by way of revenue or capital funding requests and reported to the Cabinet for any authorisations to advertise associated Traffic Regulation Orders.
