21	May 2011	Cllr Day	Appledore/Bishopsteignton – Request for daytime only waiting restrictions at junction.	Recommendation: It is not considered appropriate for junctions to have timebound restrictions. However officers

				will investigate and if justified the restrictions will be applied throughout the day.
22	May 2011	Cllr Terry	Westbourne Grove – Request for a review of the current weight restriction and associated signage.	Recommendation: The current weight restriction applies to the slip road off A127 only. This should restrict HGV use through the area. Westbourne Grove is a primary distributor designed and maintained to carry such traffic. Restricting weight limit on this route could have serious impact on the surrounding network which is not designed for such purpose. Members views are sought.
23	May 2011	Cllr Terry	Westborough Ward – Request to assess the impact of displaced parking in Westborough Ward as a result of the Hospital Parking Management Scheme, specifically in the following locations:  <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Fairfax Drive– Review yellow line restrictions, and consider strengthening pavements to facilitate pavement parking where feasible.</li> <li>2) Tintern Avenue, Springfield Drive – Assess the need for parking management in these roads.</li> </ol>	Recommendation:  That Officers monitor the parking pressures in the streets surrounding the Hospital Parking Management Scheme (PMS) with a view to taking these into consideration when the Hospital PMS is reviewed in early 2011. This is part of the routine post implementation monitoring.

To provide such a facility would cost in the region of £25,000 plus any costs to relocate statutory undertakers equipment. Advice from the arboricultural team indicates that the trees may not have to be removed however the disturbance and likely root trimming which would be required may damage the trees to the extent that they fail to thrive and gradually die.</p> <p>The financial investment needed in this regard cannot be justified in this case. Parking in this and nearby sections of Elm Road appears plentiful therefore it is recommended that this request is not pursued.</p> <p>Recommendation: Remove this item from the List</p>
2	Jan 11	Victoria Ward Members	Request to investigate extension to existing PMS in Colchester Road area westwards (roads bounded by West Road/London Road to Plough)	<p>Post implementation surveys have indicated displacement of non resident parking to the roads in the area. which needs to be dealt with. The Committee is asked to indicate priority in this regard.</p> <p>Recommendation: Members to consider this in light of existing Parking Management Scheme programme and review priorities as they see fit</p>
3	June 09	Cllr Wexham	Broadway Leigh near Seaview Road and East Street. Pedestrian refuge required.	Installation of a refuge and the requisite hatching would result in a loss of approximately 8 parking spaces.
