However, the pre-design stage survey recorded 33 residents' vehicles, which is slightly more than the number of bays available. However, this small different may be manageable as there may well be changes to car ownership or movement of residents. It is proposed not to delay scheme implementation and officer will monitor the situation and look at possible ways of accommodating additional residential parking demand. The introduction of one way systems has implications for the rest of the adjoining road network and cannot be considered in isolation. As such has not been considered part of the current proposals. If this becomes and issue then it would require further consultation. It is suggested that officers proceed with the scheme as planned and consulted and if monitoring indicates a need for additional bays, the change of traffic flow would be investigated. Double yellow lines are proposed at various locations such as junctions or areas where parking would be obstructive and unsafe. However, the extent could be reduced if the above action is agreed.
