# Petition Regarding Traffic Flows and Parking – Cromwell Road Executive Councillor: Councillor Cox A Part 1 Public Agenda Item

# 1. Purpose of Report

1.1 To advise Members of a petition received from 51 residents of Cromwell Road calling for action to address traffic flow and parking issues.

- 3.1 Through their local ward Councillor, residents have raised the issue of vehicles using the road to avoid the roundabout at Sutton Road and Eastern Avenue. Residents have also raised the issue of parking pressures created by the school located in the road.
- 3.2 To assess support for action, the local Ward Councillor and a member of the Residents Association canvassed all residents. The petition includes 51 signatures from the 81 properties.
