ACCIDENT ANALYSIS FOR A THREE YEAR PERIOD ENDING 30TH SEPTEMBER 2012(BATCH NUMBER 66)

SITE NO:	LOCATION: The Fairway
ACCIDENT SUMMARY: During the study period, 9 personal injury accidents were reported along its length which is approximately 1km (1000m). 2 accidents were reported in 2010, 5 accidents were reported in 2011 and 2 accidents were reported in 2012. 1 Accident resulted in a serious injury, 8 accidents resulted in slight injuries. 8 accidents occurred during the daylight hours. 1 accident occurred during the hours of darkness, 6 accidents occurred on a dry road surface. 3 on a wet road surface. 1 accident involved a pedestrian 2 accidents involved cyclists 2 accidents involved a motor cyclists 1 accident occurred at its junction with Eastwood Old Road. Car-Car, Nose tail in queue at box junction. 1 between Eastwood Old Road and Belfairs Park Drive. Car-Car, Nose tail vehicle stopped to let vehicle pull on to driveway. 1 at Belfairs Park Drive, P/C-Car. Cyclist on footpath crosses side road without looking or stopping. Resulting in serious injury. 1 at Thorndon Park Drive, Car-M/C. Car turns across path of M/C 2 at Moor Park Gardens, 1 involved Car-Car driver believed to have fallen asleep, 1 involved Car-M/C, car pulled out from side road, M/C braked, swerved & fell off. No contact made. 2 between Woodberry Close and Woodside. 1 involved Ped-Car, Driver impaired by alcohol went through a red light & hit pedestrian on crossing. 1 involved Car, elderly driver 87, hit a pot hole lost control & collides with a lamp column. 1 southeast of Woodside. Car, driver loses control struck telegraph pole & rolls over. Police contributory factor identifies “ illness or disability, mental or physical” as a probable cause.	
Conclusion Link between causality factors appears to be driver/rider/error or reaction (7 of 9)and also impairment or distraction (4 of 9) . No link found in time or location, day of week, month.
