1. Purpose of Report

For the Council to:

- Note the details of the Political Groups, following the Local Elections on 5th May 2022;

- Agree the subsequent changes to the Cabinet Working Parties in Part 3, Schedule 2 of the Constitution;
- To establish a new Armed Forces Working Party,
- Endorse the Council's Constitution (which is on the internet), including the Scheme of Delegation in Part 3, Schedule 3.

2.2 To note the changes to the titles and responsibilities of Cabinet Members made by the Leader of the Council, and to note that these changes will be reflected in an amendment to Schedule 1(a) of Part 3 to the Constitution (to be circulated at the meeting)

- 2.3 To note the appointments to the Cabinet (and substitutes) made by the Leader of the Council, including the arrangements for the Deputy Leader (to be circulated at the meeting as **List A**).
- 2.4 To note the appointments to the Cabinet Committee (and substitutes) made by the Leader of the Council (to be circulated at the meeting as **List B**).
- 2.5 That a new Armed Forces Working Party be established with the terms of reference set out in <u>Appendix 1</u> and that Part 3, Schedule 2 to the Constitution be amended accordingly.
- 2.6 To endorse the Council's Constitution, including the Scheme of Delegation in Part 3, Schedule 3.

3. Background

- 3.1 In accordance with Article 7 in Part 2 of the Constitution and in accordance with the law, it is for the Leader of the Council to:
 - Decide on the number of Cabinet Members and their titles and responsibilities.
 - Appoint the Cabinet Members (and substitutes).
 - Appoint the Cabinet Committee (and substitutes).
- 3.2 In terms of places on relevant <u>Committees and Sub-Committees</u>, these will be allocated on the basis of political proportionality to nominees of the 4 political groups on the Council; with the remaining places being allocated to the non-aligned councillors.
 - This matter, together with appointment of Chairs and Vice Chairs, is dealt with at **Agenda Items 5 and 6** and **List C** will be circulated at the meeting for the Council to agree.
- 3.3 In terms of appointments to <u>Working Parties</u>, <u>Forums</u>, <u>Panels etc.</u>, these will also be allocated, by convention, on the basis of political proportionality to nominees of the 4 political groups on the Council.
 - This matter, together with appointment of Chairs and Vice Chairs, is dealt with at **Agenda Items 7 and 8** and **List D** will be circulated at the meeting for the Council to agree.
- 3.4 It is recommended that a new working party be established (Armed Forces Working Party) for the purpose of the promotion and fulfilment of the Council's commitment to the Armed Forces Covenant. The terms of reference of the working party are set out in **Appendix 1.**
- 3.5 In terms of appointments to <u>Outside Bodies</u>, these will be dealt with by the Council and **List E** will be circulated at the meeting for Council to agree. (**Agenda Item 9**).

3.6 In December 2009 the High Court handed down a judgement in a case involving Leeds City Council, which confirmed that the Council did have a valid Scheme of Delegation notwithstanding the fact that it did not confirm the Scheme on an annual basis. Nevertheless, to be on the safe side it is recommended that the Council endorses the Council's Constitution (which is on the Internet), including the Scheme of Delegation in Part 3, Schedule 3.
