TOPIC: 'MAXIMISING THE USE OF TECHNOLOGY THROUGH THE SMART CITY AND DIGITAL FUTURES AGENDA"

FRAMEWORK FOR SCRUTINY / SCOPE OF PROJECT:

- I. To explore the different approaches and understand how the Council is embracing new concepts and technologies in delivering cost effective solutions across its economic, social and environmental responsibilities; its journey towards becoming a "Smart City".
- II.
