

# 8 High Impact Changes for Managing Transfers

Change	Change Descriptor
<b>1</b> Early Discharge Planning	Investment in social care resource that contributes to the integrated discharge team – <b>Pilot commenced 1<sup>st</sup> August</b>
	Investment in social care resource that contributes to the early discharge of patients with complex needs from both an acute and non acute setting – <b>In place</b>
<b>2</b> Systems to Monitor Patient Flow	Investment in technology (e.g. CareTrak) to monitor patient flow which will enable prediction of likely scenarios - joint CCG and SBC initiative (incl resource to manage) – <b>Scoping underway</b>
<b>3</b> Multi-disciplinary/Multi-Agency Discharge Teams	Social worker to develop collaborative and Multi disciplinary working in the area of CHC Joint commissioning manager for integrated discharge to assess model – <b>In place</b>
	Voluntary sector investment to increase capacity and co-ordinate activity, engagement with MDTs, enhance preventative approach (hub) and SPOA (incl wellbeing pioneer worker) – <b>Commencing Sept 17</b>
<b>4</b> Home First/Discharge to Assess	Resource to support Discharge to Assess model to assess patients who are in step down or interim beds etc
	Hospital 2 Home service that will maintain existing service whilst model is reviewed – <b>Starting Sept 17</b>
	Priority investment - resource to enable enhanced provision of step-up facility - <b>Being finalised</b>
<b>5</b> Seven-Day Service	Enhancement of Home Again service (HAS) to support the system 7/7 and complex care cohort – <b>In place</b>
	Realignment of social care working patterns to support 7 day working - <b>Scoping underway</b>
<b>6</b> Trusted Assessor	Trusted Assessor model (model to be scoped, defined and agreed) – <b>Postholder in place to take this forward</b>
<b>7</b> Focus on Choice	Resource to support the development of an asset based approach in the community and to enhance the Locality based MDT approach with a focus on enhancing choice and ensuring high quality domiciliary care provision. – <b>Recruitment underway</b>
<b>8</b> Enhancing Health in Care Homes	Gold Standard Framework (GSF) investment - further training for additional care homes to go through the GSF training – <b>Ongoing</b>
	Investment in resource to provide training for care homes in terms of fluid intake, falls prevention and nutrition – <b>Underway</b>
