

**FRANKS (formerly known as Cornichon)**

Schedule of further Conditions agreed with responsible authorities.

- 1 That the premises shall trade primarily as a Restaurant
2. That the amended proposed hours for licensable activities be  
  
Sunday to Thursday inclusive 10 00 hours – 00:00 hours  
Friday and Saturday inclusive 10 00 hours – 01 00 hours
- 3 On any occasion where the premises conducts or intends to conduct licensable activities past 23 00 hours on a Friday or Saturday, at least 2 SIA licensed door supervisors must be on duty from 20.00 hours until at least 30 minutes after the premises closes. On all other occasions where licensable activity takes place after 23 00 hours, the provision of SIA door staff shall be provided on a risk assessment basis
- 4 That there be a zero tolerance of the possession or supply of illicit drugs on the premises and that:  
  
(a) staff be trained in the awareness of misuse of drugs,  
  
(b) that regular checks will be undertaken of the toilet facilities and external areas of the premises to deter such conduct,  
  
(c) any illicit substances discovered by staff will be retained in a secure safe in the office at the premises and passed to the police at the earliest opportunity
- 5 There shall be no use of the external area between 22:00 and 08:00 the following day save as a smoking area. During those times the maximum capacity permitted within that area shall not exceed eight persons
- 6 All doors and windows to remain closed except for access and egress between 22.00 and 08.00 the following day to minimise noise breakout
7. No rubbish/bottle bins shall be emptied between 21.00 and 08:00 the following day
- 8 That a contact telephone number be provided to local residents for use during premises opening hours in the event of any concerns.

- 9 Any noise complaints will be logged and the incident and what was done to address it will be recorded. The log book shall be made available to police and local authority officers on request.
