


PROFILE VIEW: ZONE 2 SECTION 4

THESE LONG-SECTIONS COMPARE THE EXISTING GROUND LEVEL (INDICATED BY THE BLACK DASHED LINE) AND THE PROPOSED TEMPORARY LEVEL OF THE SURCHARGE MATERIAL (INDICATED BY THE RED LINE). THE LEVEL OF THE SURCHARGE MATERIAL IS BASED ON THE PROPOSED PERMANENT FINISHED LEVEL PLUS 2 METRES. WHERE RETAINING WALLS WILL FORM PART OF THE PROPOSED PERMANENT LEVELS DESIGN, THE SURCHARGE MATERIAL WILL BE TEMPORARILY BATTERED AT A SLOPE OF 1 IN 1 (45 DEGREES) AS RECOMMENDED BY THE GEOTECHNICAL CONSULTANT, IDOM.

THE PROPOSED PERMANENT FINISHED LEVELS ARE TO BE AGREED SEPARATELY AS PART OF THE DISCHARGE OF CONDITION 8.

PLEASE NOTE THAT FOR CLARITY THE VERTICAL SCALE OF THESE LONG-SECTIONS HAS BEEN MULTIPLIED BY A FACTOR OF 5. LEVEL CHANGES MAY THEREFORE APPEAR MORE ABRUPT THAN WILL BE THE CASE ON-SITE.

- 6. THE CONTRACTOR MUST ENSURE ALL WORKING AREAS ARE FULLY SECURE.
