1. Summary of progress and actions since last period

SENDOPs met on 20th April 2023 and considered the following items.

Increased risk to timely delivery of services caused by restructuring with the Integrated Care Board and shortage of staff in the Educational Psychology Service. All members of SENDOPs were reminded to add to and challenge items in the risk log.

An update from the ICB on the developing work with the Multi Schools Council.

An initial presentation around the increased number of requests and the significant increase particularly in the early years. Further analysis requested on why requests are being turned down and discussion around the challenges in meeting statutory timescales due to significant increase in demand and shortages of staff which was to be met through the recovery plan.

The Graduated Response in Southend was discussed and how the impact is measured.

An evaluation of the use of the EHC Hub over the past two years and discussion around the benefits and the challenges. The DfE approached Southend as an authority who had embraced digitization of EHC case management to feed into some national work around digital EHCPs.

An update on the revisions to the SEND coproduction charter and next steps for publication of the revised charter – SENDOPS agreed there should be a signed SEND area partnership annex on co production within wider SCC Framework.
